

*Welcome aboard the  
BART Bus System*

The BART bus system provides service around the Chequamegon Bay. This brochure describes our Monday and Thursday service from Mellen to Ashland and in the Mellen area.

**MELLEN TO ASHLAND SERVICE** is a route service that starts in Mellen and makes three trips to and from Ashland on service days. The bus leaves Northern State Bank in Mellen at 9:10 AM, 12:40 PM and 3:30 PM. A transfer from the Mellen bus to City of Ashland bus may be made at Super One. Return trips from Ashland leave Super One at 10:04, 2:04 and 4:24 pm. Riders can also board this bus at its scheduled stops in Highbridge and Marengo.

**MELLEN CITY SERVICE** is a door-to-door service that operates during the periods of time the bus is in Mellen: from 8:30 to 9:00, from 10:50 to 11:20, from 12:00 to 12:30, and from 2:50 to 3:20. This demand service requires a call to the BART dispatcher for all locations. Call 682-9664 at least 10 minutes in advance to arrange your ride.

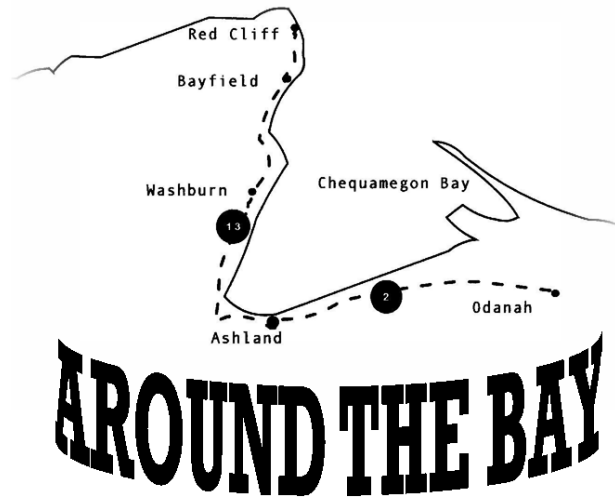

**While you are riding**

Please observe the following rules and suggestions to ensure a safe and pleasant trip.

1. Save the front seats for senior citizens and people with disabilities.
2. Do not have distracting conversations with the bus operator.
3. The use of improper language, boisterous behavior or fighting may result in a rider being prohibited from riding the bus.
4. No personal errand stops are allowed, once you leave the bus you pay a new fare.
